You will also be required to pay security for costs. The decision may only be set aside if the judge or court officer is satisfied that
 - (a) you have a reasonable explanation for failing to file a defence or you did not willfully or deliberately fail to appear at the hearing
 - (b) you filed your application to set aside this decision as soon as reasonably possible after learning of the decision on the claim, or you have a satisfactory explanation for any delay in filing your application;
and
 - (c) it is fair and just in the circumstances to set aside the decision.
2. The decision made at the set aside hearing is final and cannot be appealed.
